

2009 Summer Camp Offerings

For students in 6th and 7th grade!

Are you looking for something exciting to do this summer? Check out these summer camp opportunities to explore career areas through hands-on activities!

CAMPS WILL BE HELD July 21-23, 2009

Electrical Wiring Camp

Students will be introduced to basic electrical circuitry, with emphasis placed on electrical polarity. Develop skills in electrical safety and wire basic circuits such as a single pole switch, a three way circuit, duplex receptacle circuit and a door bell. This camp will be held at the Crawford County Career and Technical Center on July 21, 22 and 23 in order to complete the complex camp project. Camp will run from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. This camp is limited to 10 students.

Lego Robotics Camp

Students will familiarize students with robotics and intelligent systems and provides a challenging hands-on introduction to the project management process. Students will learn "What is Robotics", key terminology and the robotic development timeline. This camp will be held in a classroom at the Meadville Area Middle School and students will choose between July 21, 22 or 23 to attend this camp. This camp is limited to 10 students per day. Camp will run from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day

Tool & Die CNC Camp at PMI

Students who attend this camp will have the opportunity to learn about computer design and manufacturing using Computer Numerical Control (CNC) machines. Students will design and manufacture their own project using computers and various pieces of manufacturing equipment. This camp will be held at the Precision Manufacturing Institute on Bessemer Street in Meadville. Students will attend this camp on July 21, 22 and 23, 2009 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day. This camp is limited to 8 students.

TRANSPORTATION

There is a \$35.00 registration fee per student to attend a summer camp. Scholarships are available to those students who are experiencing financial difficulties and cannot afford the \$35.00 registration fee. To request a camp scholarship to cover the registration fee, mark the registration form accordingly.

DRESS APPROPRIATELY FOR CAMP

Students are to wear closed-toe shoes each day of the camp. **Flip flops or sandals are NOT ALLOWED!** This is for the safety of all students participating in the Summer Camps.

Medical forms will be mailed with the registration confirmation letter, scholarship form (if applicable) and transportation schedule (if applicable) at least two weeks before the start of the 2009 Summer Camps.
