

Lesson Plan

Objective:

The student will be able to identify the steps used in caring for vintage clothing.

Procedure:

Show garments made from: Cotton
Wool
Silk

Show the types of hand stitching that was used in construction.

Discussion on how to clean each fabric.

Samples of cleaning materials used then and today.

Demonstrate specific hand washing of each type of fabric.

Proper handling and storage of vintage clothing: acid free paper, white gloves,
acid free

boxes and lids, and padded hangers

Discussion on the effects of improper handling of vintage clothing.

Review:

Have students make up 3 questions on what they learned.

Have the students demonstrate the steps used in caring for vintage clothing.

Follow-up:

Tour the Baldwin Reynolds House Meseum in September 200 for the fashion exhibit.
