B. Objectives

The child(ren) will show an interest in books and read aloud stories.

The child(ren) will be able to make a prediction about what comes next in the story.

The child(ren) will show a curiosity toward live baby chicks.

The child(ren) will recognize and demonstrate the importance of hand washing.

C. Introduction/Motivation

Children are introduced to live baby chicks.

Explain we will be reading a story about a mother hen and her chicks.

Tell the children that good readers make predictions about characters and events in the story as they read.

D. Activity/Procedure

Read The Little Red Hen. Use flannel board figures from the story.

Ask the children as the story is read: "What do you think will happen?" "Why do you think that will happen?"

Encourage them to join in saying: "Not I."

Show various kinds of breads and butter.

Make homemade butter.

E. Materials

A copy of the book The Little Red Hen

Flannel board and flannel board figures

Bird related books

Heavy cream, salt, one container (with secured lid) per child

Various kinds of bread

Take home packets for parent/guardian and child.

F. Assessment

The children are assessed by observation and their responses to questions. In a classroom setting, records would be kept to see if the objectives were met by each individual.
